Data Protection

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that comes into effect on the 25th of May 2018 requires schools to appoint a Data Protection Officer (DPO). Schools can decide to appoint this person individually, share one with other schools or (as in the case of our school) contract the role and responsibilities to a third party provider. Illuminate Learning Ltd has been contracted to provide the DPO services for your child's school.
