1. Download the app

Search '**BoomReader Parents**' or go to:

boomreader.co.uk/parents

2. Connect

When prompted, use the details given by your child's teacher to connect to their account.

You will be given the school code and your child's pin code.

If you have other children in the school? No worries - you can add them by tapping '+ child' on the app.

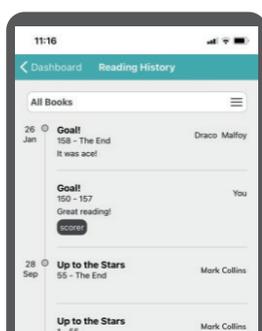
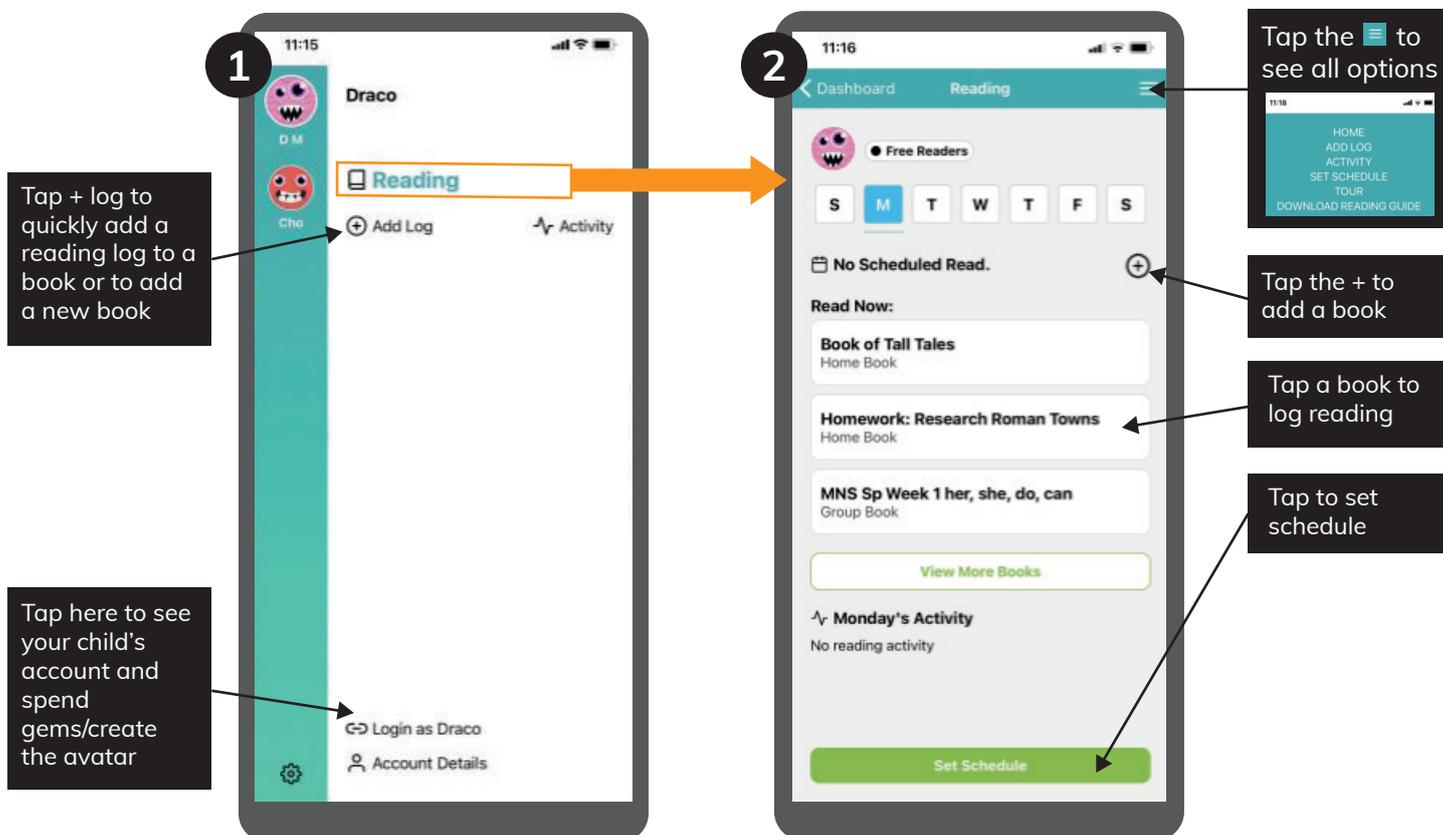
ATTENDANCE

Well done to classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 10 for achieving over 96% attendance in the last week before the holidays.

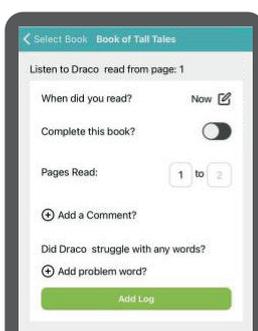

Please follow this simple guide to help you use the app.

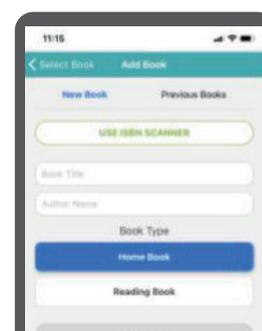
Here is the main screen (fig 1) you will see after logging in and completing the tour.
